Overview

Nara Training offers this qualification under traineeship arrangements. A traineeship combines practical work experience with structured training to provide a nationally recognised qualification (CPC30508). Trainees must be employed in the relevant industry sector to undertake a traineeship.

Nara Training & Assessing offers the dogging skills set to individuals as requested and you do not have to complete the whole qualification in order to obtain the WorkSafe accredited ticket. Refer to the link to the Dogging Training Program Information sheet for more details.

What does a trainee do as part of Certificate III in Dogging?

- Attach slings; and
- Direct the movements of loads handled by cranes in locations such as manufacturing plants, construction and mining sites and the maritime industry.

Key Outcomes

This qualification has compulsory requirements that cover common skills for the construction industry, as well as a specialist field of work.

The construction industry strongly affirms that training and assessment leading to recognition of skills must be undertaken in a real or very closely simulated workplace environment and this qualification requires all units of competency to be delivered in this context.

Completion of the general induction training program specified by the National Code of Practice for Induction Training for Construction Work (SAC 2006) is required before entering a construction work site. Achievement of unit CPCCOHS1001A covers this requirement.

Course Outline

15 units of competency are required for award of this qualification:

- 11 compulsory units
- 4 elective units

A maximum of one of the four required elective units may be substituted by selecting relevant units of competency from any Certificate III or IV construction qualification or qualification in another endorsed Training Package.
